

MATH Building Emergency

Quick Reference

REMEMBER, WHEN YOU HEAR:

- ALL HAZARDS SIRENS immediately seek shelter (**Shelter-In-Place**) in a safe location within closest facility
- FIRE ALARMS immediately **evacuate** the building and move to a safe location

In both cases, you should seek additional clarifying information by all possible means...Purdue Homepage, TV, radio, email, etc.

Shelter in place means seeking immediate shelter inside a building or University residence. This course of action may need to be taken during a tornado, earthquake, release of hazardous materials in the outside air, or a civil disturbance. When you hear the sirens immediately go inside a building to a safe location and use all communication means available to find out more details about the emergency. Remain in place until police, fire, or other emergency response personnel provide additional guidance or tell you it is safe to leave.

Fire:

In the event of a fire alarm it is important to quickly and calmly gather your belongings and exit the building via the stairwells on the North and South side of the building. Clear the building and join other building occupants at the assembly point.

- The assembly point is the sidewalk between the Recitation Building (REC) and the Class of 50 Lecture Hall (CL50).
- In the case of inclement weather occupants should gather quietly in the lobby of CL50.

Tornado Warning:

In the event of a tornado warning you are to shelter inside the building. The hazard siren outside will sound and the tornado warning will be identified via NOAA, local news outlets, Purdue Alerts, e-mail or the Purdue Homepage.

- Evacuate all exterior offices and lobby areas and head to the lower floors via stairwells.
- Floors 7, 8, 9 and 10 should evacuate to the Ground floor.
- Floors Main, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 should evacuate to the Basement floor.
- Those on the Basement and Ground floors should shelter in their offices.

Other Shelter in Place:

In the event that there is an active shooter, intruder, or chemical spill, or other condition requiring you to shelter in place go to an office, close and secure all doors and windows and check the Purdue Homepage, news outlets, and Purdue alerts for further instructions.
